ABOUT THE DEGREE

The Master of Science in Applied Psychology provides a 5th year qualification to students who have successfully completed the 4th year Curtin Graduate Diploma in Psychological Science (or equivalent). It provides an essential transition from the theory-based undergraduate degree program to an application-oriented postgraduate training in Psychology and prepares students for professional practice. This program constitutes the final year of a 5-year master's level pathway and includes a supervised fieldwork component.

On completion of this master's students will be able to:

- Register as Professional Psychologists with the AHPC
- Coordinate and evaluate psychological interventions projects in profit-making as well as in non-profit making organisations
- Conduct psychological assessments which measure cognitive ability and susceptibility for psychological disorders
- Provide counselling services to a diverse set of individuals
- Conduct quantitative and qualitative research as academics
- · Be eligible for enrolment in PhD programs

COURSE ESSENTIALS

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN APPLIED PSYCHOLOGY

Course entry requirements

- A 4-year Bachelor of Psychology with CWA 65% in the final year OR a 3 year Bachelor of Psychology AND 1 year Graduate Diploma in Psychological Science
- Must meet Curtin English entry requirement IELTS 6.5 or equivalent

Duration

The program is run over 1 year.

Application procedures

Candidates must complete the application form available at Curtin Mauritius Future Students Centre and must submit relevant copies of the following documents:

- · Copies of educational qualifications
- Two passport size photographs
- · Copy of National Identity Card and Birth Certificate

(The originals of the above documents are needed for certification purposes)

PROFESSIONAL RECOGNITION & COURSE ACCREDITATION

The Master of Science in Applied Psychology constitutes the 5th year of a 5-year training pathway*.
