

CERTIFICATE III IN PATHOLOGY COLLECTION

WHAT IS IT?

The Certificate III in Pathology Collection course prepares trainees for a career as a **phlebotomist** or **pathology samples' collector** in a variety of health services, such as pathology collection centers, laboratories, hospitals, and clinics.

In this course, Students will learn:

- · Communication and customer service
- · Pathology collection techniques
- Phlebotomy (blood collection)
- Infection control
- Work health and safety
- Medical terminology
- Visiting clients in their place of residence
- Electrocardiography (ECG)

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Three (3) O-Levels or equivalent
- Credit in English at O-Levels, or pass CTE English Entrance Test

Alternatively, Candidates gain entry through a portfolio submission followed by an entrance exam and an interview conducted in English.

BECOMING A PHLEBOTOMIST

Phlebotomy is an expanding field with excellent career opportunities in the health sector both locally and internationally. Student can progress their career by completing more advanced courses such as Laboratory Technician or Nursing Studies.

During their course of study, students will gradually acquire the following skills and attributes:

- Communicate with empathy when interacting with patients
- Ability to work unsupervised
- Ability to work co-operatively within a multidisciplinary team

- · Computer literacy and accurate recording skills
- Perform pathology sample collections in a variety of settings including hospital wards, outpatient clinics, off-site collection rooms and home collection services.
