- > Complete one ACA Professional Level exam
- > Undertake work placements at PwC during which you will work with audit clients and develop your professional network
- > Enjoy student vacation

- > Complete eight Curtin study units
- > Complete two ACA Professional Level exam
- > Undertake work placements at PwC Work with audit clients and develop a network at PwC
- > Enjoy student vacation
