A graduate can be nominated for a maximum of two award categories. A graduate cannot win more than one award category in any calendar year and cannot win the same award category more than once. **Self-nominations are accepted.** An Alumni Award will not normally be awarded to a person who is a serving member of Curtin University Council, an Adjunct Professor, a current member of the University staff (any person on a current Curtin contract, receiving remuneration from Curtin for their work), or a serving federal, state or local government politician (or the international equivalent).
